

CRY – CAMS – SCSTEDS

VALUE ADDITION TECHNICAL TRAINING CENTER REPORT -2020

- The Value Addition Technical Training Center also known as Digital Training Center was established with the support of CAMS – CRY in January 2020.
- The Digital Learning Centre houses all the equipment's and accessories required for conduct of Burlington English language learning sessions, K-yan Educational Learning accessories, Digital Online learning equipment pertaining to conduct of academic curriculum learning and sports curriculum learning in addition to Central library.
- The Digital Training Center learning equipment consists of Computer systems(4Nos), K-YanEducational Media equipment(2nos) with display board, Digital Television with WiFi connection, Camcorder(1no), Laptop(1no) White Board with Markers.
- The Digital Training Center function between 9am to 9pm all days(365days in a year)
- The Digital Training Center facilities are availed round the clock by students numbering 460 students hailing from in and around slums at Vyasarpadi.
- The Learning sessions are bifurcated into English language session, K-yanEducative sessions (Class 3rd to Class 12th), Basic Computer Education (All age groups), academic curriculum learning cum sports curriculum learning sessions through television and finally library session.
- In Burlington English sessions student learn Language proficiently and classes are conducted and monitored by learn worth English academy and their performance evaluated through online monitoring feedback system. Through Burlington English sessions, every child goes through different grades of learning wherein they equip themselves in language proficiency and move up to a level of fluency over a stipulated period of time
- K-yan Educative media classes are conducted for Class 3rd to Class 12th everyday for subjects namely English, Tamil and Maths. This learning is supported through video and audio presentation using K-yan education media kit.

- Tuition classes for weak students in addition to late night study sessions are conducted for subjects namely Science (Physics and Chemistry), Accounts, Commerce, Computer Science, Social Science, Maths and English.
- Special classes for 10th and 12th board students are conducted for subject Mathematics, Science (Physics and Chemistry, Biology) Accounts, Commerce, Computer Science, Social Science and language in addition to in-depth tuition study
- Academic curriculum learning for subject English grammar, English pronunciation, Accountancy and Maths classes are supported via video sessions using digital television with Wifi.
- Sports curriculum including practice sessions are taught using video through YouTube and other links with Digital television.
- Student visit library and learn co-curricular and extra-curricular subjects of varied interests through books and journals available in the central library at “Digital Training Center”.
- Students use Digital training center for drawing, painting and other craft & art work practice sessions to participate in state and national level competition.
- This Center is also used to conduct medical camps for underprivileged slum children and their families in addition to student and parent special counseling sessions.

To sum up this Digital Training Center supported by CAMS serves as a center for multiple tasks of complete usage for over all community development of underprivileged children of slums vyasarpadi.

- The Special Coaching sessions for 10th and 12th Students helped STEDS achieve 100% pass percentage for all 30 students who were given special attention and long hours of coaching. However among 20 students coached for 12th Board 18 students cleared and 2 students missed out narrowly. However they are being counseled and motivated and taught him special to reappear and pass in supplementary.
- For rest all students belonging to class 4th to Class 9th and Class 11th all students passed(Thanks to STEDS center long Coaching hours)
