I. <u>PARTNER LEVEL THEME-WISE PROGRAMME HIGHLIGHTS, CONSOLIDATED AT REGIONAL LEVEL:</u>

A. Education:

(Significant impacts and achievements during the last the reporting month)

- CRY and CAMS joint initiative "Value Addition Technical Training Center" is functioning well with conduct of Kyan Technical sessions and Burlington English Courses.
- The children are being trained to understand and speak English through online interactive sessions comprising of different methodological modules in variable batches. The Burlington English Classes are conducted in digital center for direct interaction with children's
- Kyan Educative classes were also conducted in grounds during covid times because the children's don't get deviated to child labor.
- The Educative K-yan classes with focus on Maths, Language, Science and Social Studies for primary and high school students are conducted round the clock.
- Special Educative K-yan Classes were repeatedly conducted with Emphasis on revision.
- Through SCSTEDS CRY Initiative a Trainer to Trainee Education model was started for 10 children's and adults. Through this initiative Basics Accounts, Tally, GST and IT Return filings are taught.



B. <u>Health & Nutrition:</u> (Significant impacts and achievements during the last the reporting month)

- Regular Team visits to anganwadi's and solicited support for nutrition to children.
- Two Schools have initiated for mid day meals through the help of Amma Unavagam, through this process the school children have been immensely benefitted.
- With support of Greater Chennai Corporation, covid testing was implanted in many areas with campaign on covid advisory.
- During the months of April, May, June and July food relief distribution was carried out with the help of local philanthropist and over 1400 families of slums in and around Vyasarpadi were benefitted.
- During august, a local philanthropist Dr.Girija MDS supported a Dental Camp for children's of Vyasarpadi. Over 130 Children's were beneficiaries.
- STEDS Team provided nutrition support to anganwadi's of JJR Nagar and Kalyanapuram slums.
- A Consultant from CRY has been creating awareness on vaccination among Vyasarpadi slum dweller families.



C. <u>Protection:</u> (Significant impacts and achievements during the last the reporting month)

- During the covid lockdown period many childrens were forced to Child Labour on being deprived of family earning because of their family situations. In total 16 Childrens were counselled and 7 Childrens have been enrolled back to school till date.
- In the month of june schools have started enrolling 11th grade children and master along with team enrolled 20 childrens through sports and merit quota.
- Children passed out of schools now enrolled for SCSTEDS CRY Trainer to Trainee Education Model. By this way the adult children's are protected from dropout of continuing education.
- During August, 12th Standard children (5) got admitted to college through sports quota.
- 12th Grade passed out children took part in new initiative of SCSTEDS Canva(Picture Editing) at STEDS-CRY Training Center.



D. Participation:

(Significant impacts and achievements during the last the reporting month)

 During august a big soccer event was conducted for under 15 children's of local slums. In this tourney over 24 teams participated from various slums and other places. In the final match between STEDS vs Mount FC, STEDS team scored 6-0 goal and won. In this match ISL Chennaiyin FC star "Edwin Vanspaul" Chennai City FC player "Sriram" and our STEDS star ISL "Nandha Kumar" were Guests for the tourney.

- Daily practise sessions was conducted in morning and evening @SM Nagar Ground, Mullai Nagar Ground.Inaddition campaign matches at Kannigapuram Ground for protection of childrens from child labour, dropout and others.
- For protection of Children's, 2 months ago children's are concentrated into carom and chess games to concentrate more and don't divert into other activities, through this process carom match for inter district has been conducting, for this our children's are selected for the tournament through selection process.
- Ambedkar Scout Group conducted Independence Day Program at Mullai Nagar Astro Turf Ground, Vyasarpadi. Oner 60 members attended the program where children competition was conducted and prizes were distributed.



- Collective girl children participated in girls football match with collective of other local slums namely kannigapuram, pulianthope, Vyasarpadi, korrukupet, tondairpet etc., overall our team girls won the first place.
- During August CRY Sun Anganwadi Stone plaque was mounted at all 26 anganwadi centers.
- CRY Hyper Verge academy conducted a Coding Experience Classes for children. Through these classes 10 children benefitted. Many ideas and questions were shared through this program as children got educated on basis of Coding.
- During COVID a daily practise sessions was conducted in morning and evening @SM Nagar Ground for Health and protection of children from covid. Over 90 Children attended daily sessions.

- Ambedkar Scout Group Scouts & Guides conducted a rally program on COVID Awareness for slum peoples of Vyasarpadi. Through this Initiative food relief was provided 200 slum dwellers.
- SCSTEDS CRY conducted an essay competition program at Mullai Nagar Ground on the theme "Protection and Prevention on COVID situations". In this over 54 children participated in essay competition and overall 3 children nominated as first, second and third with the assistance of two teachers.
- SCSTEDS CRY a Medical Camp was conducted at Slum Vyasarpadi for two wards on different days. Greater Chennai Corporation made the camp and awareness camp for 46th and 37th ward. Around 450 Children and families benefitted from this camp.



E. <u>Child Centre - Life Skill Modules:</u> (Significant impacts and achievements during the last the reporting month)

- Through CRY weekly activity modules session over 392 Children participate online as well as at Digital Training Center and Ground. In this weekly program, many children attend eagerly in all activity sessions.
- Through Bharath Scout & Guides a life skill sessions was conducted by Master on zoom call on the topics of "Self Improvement, Self Identity and awareness on Covid Situations"
- In CRY Volunteer Engagement session over 80 Children participate every week on Wednesday, Saturday and Sunday activity programs. Many children attend this on own interest as new information and knowledge are being shared.
- By CRY Urban Rapid Assessment Program, over 50 children from slums have been identified and their data entered into Google sheet forms.
- A rally was organised by Dr.Ambedkar college Social work department students on educating people about postpartum depression. The Session on postpartum depression was beneficial to all women and it was appreciated in special by anganwadi women.
- To protect children from getting distracted carom and chess games are conducted regularly and daily.



F. Digi-Centre / Resource Centre Programming: (Significant impacts and achievements during the last the reporting month)

- Through SCSTEDS CRY Initiative a Trainer to Trainee Education model commenced for 10 childrens and adults. Through this initiative Basics of Accounts, Tally, GST and Filings of Returns & Basics of Computer are taught.
- Canva editing sessions are being regularly conducted and 10 children have learnt the expertise in detail.
- Burlington English Sessions are being conducted and children have begun to speak the basics through this program.
- Arts and Crafts classes are conducted daily to help children overcome the stress of online classes.
- Special Coaching classes for 10th students are held regularly to help children to overcome the fear of board exams.



✓ i Meal Update:

 We getting to complete data entry (MIS) into CRY Pragathi application. Only the pending of one area is to be completed it will be completed within this week.

✓ COVID Relief Work:

We Slum Children STEDS, started our next initiative towards this big pandemic COVID-19, through our local volunteers of Slum Children STEDS joined hands to fight against COVID 19. Through our first step we started to support food relief for poor peoples. On this cause we collected resources from our local philanthropists and engaged to do food relief. First we have started with 450 peoples (Brinji and Water Bottle) around roadside, temples, parks and poor people who surrounded near our local slums. On the second relief we reached to 500 peoples with items of Sambar Rice, Egg and Water Bottle of poor around North Chennai. By end we totally reached to 1400 families around Vyasarpadi and other areas of north Chennai.
